### ◆ Fellowship group questions ◆

Questions to use, select from or supplement

- How would you explain or define God's 'glory'?
- Why does Jesus respond to his mother as he does in v4? What areas does the authority of Jesus make you uncomfortable in your life? How do you respond?
- It is Jesus who gives you 'clean hands and a pure heart' towards God. What does this free you *from*, and free you *for*? Allow some quietness to respond in worship.
- Read 2v9-10 again, then look at Jn 3v27-30, Eph 5v22-33, Rev 21v1-4. Considering the image of the wedding, what responsibility is Jesus taking in these verses? How does the 700 litres of wine and 'saving the best till now' speak of Jesus' glory?
- How is your faith stirred to respond to his glory? Be both general and specific!
