Questions to use, select from or supplement

- Read Jeremiah 33v14-26 again. What will this descendent of David do? From Jeremiah's perspective, why is this so important?
- Why is it important that Jeremiah knows there will always be priests? What do priests do?
- Who are the 'descendants of David my servant and the Levites' in v22? These verses may make our minds go back to OT stories and NT promises. Which ones. Why?
- How can we be certain it will happen (see v14, 26 and v20-26 in particular)
- From our perspective as New testament Christians, how do these verses make you feel? How does this show the Bible is one connected story and purpose, not two?
- If someone said to you 'who is at the heart of the book of Jeremiah?' what would you say and why?
- God says to us 'I will restore your fortunes and have compassion on you' (v26) What does this mean and what difference should it make?

Spend some time praying for one another, that we as individuals and a church would live this out.
