



Fellowship group questions

- Read through the whole of Psalm 19 together. What bits of the psalm do you really like, do you struggle with or not understand?

- Where and when have you most been struck with the glory of God seen in what He has made?
- To David, the law brings something to our knowledge of God that seeing creation can't. What is it? Why is it so 'delightful'? Are you genuinely as passionate about the revelation of scripture as you are about creation?
- Look at the words David uses to describe how God's revelation changes us. Which of these is most attractive to you at the moment? Why?
- Are you living in awareness of the warnings of the 'law' (v11-13) like David is?
- Verse 14 summarises David's desire. What is it and why? What does it mean that God is LORD, rock and redeemer?

Pray for one another, asking each person to share one thing they would like praying for from the verses, and one thing for the coming week.
