Discussion group questions

Some of these questions are personal and others are more general. You will find it helpful to have heard the talk so why not listen at <http://leightonbaptists.org.uk/media-links/current-teaching/>

- At the start of the Lord's prayer we pray *'Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven'* (Matt 6v10). What does this mean?
- Be honest—what difference does the 2% of the week you spend with the church have on the rest of your week? What should be the link between our church community and the way we live?
- Look at the parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10v25-37). What is the problem with the lawyer? (v25-29) Can we fall into the same attitude/trap? How?
- Describe what the Samaritan does and why his behaviour is such a surprise. (v30-35) What makes him a good neighbour? How should we see Jesus describing himself when we see the Good Samaritan?
- Think about walking up your street and look carefully at v31-35. How should following in the footsteps of Jesus affect our attitude and behaviour to those around us? (If possible, be specific) How might our discipleship group help us?
- Jesus said 'Go and do likewise'. What does he have in mind for us?

Spend sometime praying for one another, that we would be people who desire to love God and therefore love our neighbours.
