## Discussion group questions

- Read Romans 6v1-11. Think about Jesus journey through the cross; through life, death, burial, resurrection and new life. Where do we see these stages represented in v1-11
- What does it mean for us to have been 'united' (v5) with Jesus?
- Because Jesus has been raised from the dead, what (from v1-11) difference does, and should that make to us?
- What do you think it means to be 'freed from sin'? Do you feel like that?
- What is to be our motivation to serve others (v8)? What does this mean?
- Baptism marks the most profound change possible that happened when we became Christians. If you could share one thing about what this means to you personally with the group, what would it be?
- How does the way we live our lives reflect this profound change the gospel has made. Where do we need prayer for this to shape us?

### At Work

- When was the most recent time you were able to talk about your faith with someone who doesn't know Jesus; at work or over the garden gate. What happened. Who can we pray for?

### Worship

- Spend some time together in worship, giving thanks for the gospel, for Jesus and his work on our behalf that brings us freedom at the cross. And pray for on another!
