Some of these questions are personal and others are more general. **Feel free to pick and choose which questions your group will find most helpful.**

1. ***'Nobody should seek his own good, but the good of others.'*** (v24)
  - What is your reaction to this statement?
  - What difficulties or questions does it raise?
  - Think of 2 places in your life where this particularly hits home at the moment.
  - Pray about them
  
2. ***'The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it'*** (v26)
  - What is your reaction to this quote (Psalm 24)?
  - What difficulties or questions does it raise?
  - Think of 2 places in your life where this particularly hits home at the moment.
  - Pray about them and worship God
  
3. ***'So whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God'*** (v31)
  - What is your reaction to this statement?
  - What difficulties or questions does it raise?
  - Think of 2 places in your life where this particularly hits home at the moment.
  - Ask God to help you to have him at the centre
  
4. ***'I am not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be saved. Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.'*** (v33 and 11v1) Pray that this would be true of us.
