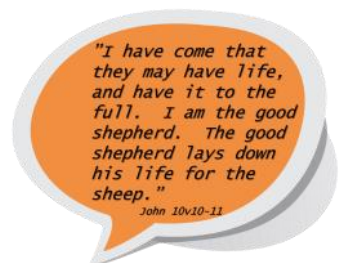

Some of these questions are personal and others are more general. Feel free to pick and choose which questions your group will find most helpful.

- 1) Read Ezekiel 34v1-10. Who are the 'Shepherds?' What is God's accusation against them? What is he going to do to the Shepherds?
- 2) Read Ezekiel 34v11-16. How is God going to overturn the wreckage caused by the Shepherds?
- 3) Describe how you imagine the 'sheep' feel, hearing this description. Summarise what God is going to do.
- 4) Read Ezekiel 34v17-24. Who is God addressing in these verses? Where and when do these verses find their hope? Can you see yourself in these verses?
- 5) Read Ezekiel 34v25-31. These verses speak of many blessings. What are they?
- 6) Read John 10v10 again. At first glance how do we understand this verse? How does the background of Ezekiel 34 help us.
- 7) What kind of life does God want for you? How committed is he to your knowing and getting it?
