•2v37-41—'What shall we do?'

⇒Promise Kept—God calls people to be saved & forgiven

Some of these questions are personal and others are more general. Feel free to pick and choose which questions your group will find most helpful.

1. What particularly spoke to you or challenged you from these verses?
2. Look through the chapter. List the things the Holy Spirit does. Which of these do we tend to emphasise or ignore?
3. What seems to be the primary purpose of the Holy Spirit in these verses?
4. Read v17-18. What is the main point of these verses? Do you believe this...particularly about you?
5. How conscious are you that you are dependent upon the Holy Spirit day-by-day?
6. Look at v36—Pick out 2 things that show Jesus is Lord, and 2 that he is Christ (Saviour/rescuer) from these verses.
7. Do you remember the last time you were 'cut to the heart' or deeply affected by the Spirit speaking the word of God to you? Can you share it?
8. What are the encouragements in v38-41 for our evangelism?

Ask God to bring glory to his name by the Holy Spirit clearly showing you again who Jesus is and pray for opportunities to share him.
