

Some of these questions are personal and others are more general. Feel free to pick and choose which questions your group will find most helpful.

1. Read Mark 10v13-31. Why do you think the disciples rebuked the people (v13)?
2. What part did the people play in Jesus blessing the children? How does this speak to us as we focus on making disciples?
3. What does the rich young man have going for him in v17-22? Why are the children better off than he is?
4. What is the focus of the man's worship? What is the focus of the children's worship?
5. 'It is easier for the impossible to happen than for someone to enter God's kingdom.' Why doesn't this sentence make discipleship pointless? How can we have any confidence in making disciples?
6. In v24, Jesus calls his disciples 'children'. Why might this help explain v28-31. Why is this so hard to live in our day and age?
7. What are the stumbling blocks to you more fully receiving the kingdom of God like a child? What do you need to do with these stumbling blocks?
8. How do we, like the disciples in v13, try and make the kingdom work 'our way'?

Ask God for grace and mercy to receive from him. Pray that we as a church would receive willingly from the Lord.
